On May 10, 2013, at a ceremony at the Montana State Capital in Helena, MT, Howard H. Knight was officially endorsed into the coveted Montana Circle of Masters.

Montana, The Land of Creativity, has a tradition of breeding a "can-do" creative spirit. The Montana Arts Council's Montana Circle of American Masters (MCAM) honors that spirit while celebrating and reminding us of who we are and where we live.

Only 39 artists have ever received this honor to date and Montana is the only state in the Union that honors their American Masters in this important way.
